The Santander Visiting Fellow will undertake research related to contemporary Spain and Portugal including their role in the EU and their relations with Latin America and global politics. Candidates from the 11 countries in the *Santander Universities' Network* are encouraged to apply. This Network covers institutions in Argentina, Brazil, Chile, Colombia, Mexico, Peru, Puerto Rico, Uruguay, Venezuela, Spain and Portugal.

Director of the European Studies Centre, Professor Kalypso Nicolaidis, said: 'There are many areas of mutual interest between Santander Universities and St Antony's College and we are grateful for the support that the Group has pledged for our research. As an added bonus, we look forward to working together on other initiatives, such as ways to improve banking support to our international students.'

Through its 'Santander Universities' Global Division, Banco Santander has channelled since 1996 almost half a billion euros into academia through co-operative agreements with 700 universities in Spain, Latin America, Portugal, Russia, China, the United States and the United Kingdom.
